RANGE SAFETY RULES

Types of firearm & ammunition allowed on the range

All handguns, rifles, & shotguns may be used. No cartridges loaded with tracer, incendiary or metal piercing bullets are permitted on the shooting range.

Safety Measures

Once you have entered the gate, arrived at the shooting area, and a red warning flag is hoisted at the entrance area, the range is considered as being in use. Once shooting is completed, the flag will be lowered and removed, and the shooting area can be considered as safe and not in use.

Rules of conduct for shooters

- No person entering this range may be under the influence of either alcohol or drugs.
- Only individuals who are paid up members, or are under the immediate supervision of such person, are entitled to handle a firearm or shoot on this range.
- Eye and hearing protection is compulsory and shall be worn at all times during shooting.
- The appointed Range Officer (RO) is in absolute control of the range, and his instruction will be followed without question.
- Firearms shall only be loaded at the firing point, on instruction from the RO, with the barrel pointing at the backstop.
- Firearms shall be holstered or placed down unloaded whenever shooting is interrupted.
- Only the targets shall be fired at.
- No shooting shall be done at metal or hard targets at a distance of less than 10 metres since this poses a ricochet hazard
- Turning around with a loaded firearm is forbidden, except when safely holstered.
- Under no circumstances may firearms be handled if anyone is in front of the firing point.
- Other peoples' firearms shall not be touched without the express permission of the owner.
